

**IDF Europe Prize in Diabetes 2014** 

### Call for Applications

IDF Europe will be awarding a European diabetes prize that aims to recognize excellence, innovation, passion and commitment in Diabetes.

IDF Europe is convinced that this award will help increase awareness about diabetes and recognize outstanding individuals who have dedicated themselves to improving the lives of people with diabetes.

IDF Europe has identified a category of recipient of this prize.

#### Young Researchers

#### <u>Eligibility</u>

- The applicant must be nominated by a peer and preferably working in Europe.
- The applicant must be a qualified health care professional aged 40 years or younger.

• The applicant should be involved in innovative patient-oriented research in diabetes and its complications. The works should show her/his commitment to the diabetes research in order to improve the health outcomes for people with diabetes.

The priority will be given to researches focusing on pathophysiology of diabetes, epidemiology, education, behavioural research, care to disadvantaged populations, innovative approaches in diabetes care and treatment.

SPECIAL NOTE: the winner or a representative has to be able to participate in the award ceremony.

#### How to apply?

In addition to the application form and **CV of the candidate** 

• The peer who nominates the applicant should send a short essay (500 words maximum).

• A brief report on the outcome basic/clinical research(es) which forms the basis for the application. The research(es) should be carried out fully/partly in Europe.

• If the research(es) is (are) published, a copy of the publication(s) should also be sent. If not yet published, a supporting statement by the supervisor or Head of the Department indicating that the nominee is the principal investigator of the research(es)

• Other supporting documents will be included to the application.

The winner of the 2014 edition of the IDF Europe Prize in Diabetes will be notified of the decision of the Nominating Committee by 15 October, and will be invited to take part in the awarding ceremony, which will take place in the European Parliament in Brussels on World Diabetes Day event, i.e. 5 November 2014.

The winner will be awarded a 10,000 Euro prize, which will be donated to a diabetes charity of the winner's choice, as well as a commemorative plaque and a certificate. The winner will also receive a 1,000 Euro honorarium.

All applications must be submitted in electronic format by **15 August** 2014.
